

Shirts must cover appropriately (no bare backs, bellies or sides) and not include any inappropriate graphics or sayings. Tank tops are not permitted. Hats are not permitted unless specified as a hat day.

Friday will still be church uniforms and keep in mind that they should wear something on Tuesday that is comfortable enough for gym, including tennis shoes.
