We are almost half way through the school year, and we have many families who have not entered any fundraising in the Family Share Tracker yet.

While we will obviously be limiting the necessary volunteer time and cafeteria days, it is more important than ever that everyone do their part to help with fundraising.

The Diocese requires that 10% of the school's operating budget must come from fundraising. That works out to approximately \$100,000.

St. Gregory School expects each family to sell a minimum of \$300 worth of fundraisers. So far only 57 school families have entered fundraising in the Family Share Tracker. That means about 90 families have not entered anything yet.
