Dear Kindergarten Parents,

I am the Seneca Valley School District certified school nurse who maintains the Saint Gregory School health files. As a reminder, children entering kindergarten in Pennsylvania are required to complete the following examinations and immunizations:

1. Medical examination PA Private Physical Form

2. Dental examination Private Dentist Report.docx

The required examinations should be completed within a year of your child's entry into school. The physical and dental forms are to be completed by the physician and dentist performing the examinations with the student's name clearly marked and returned to Saint Gregory School Office anytime prior to the first day of school.

3. Immunizations required are listed below:

Diphtheria-Tetanus-Pertussis	4 doses (1 dose must be on or after 4 th birthday)
Polio	4 doses (1 dose must be on or after 4 th birthday)
Measles, Mumps, Rubella	2 doses (1st dose after the first birthday)
Hepatitis B	3 doses (appropriately spaced)
Varicella (chickenpox) 2	2 doses of varicella vaccine (1st dose after 1st birthday) or
	history of disease

¹ Measles, mumps & rubella are usually administered as one shot called MMR.

In addition, as part of our commitment to student health and wellness, attached below is important information regarding diabetes management to all Kindergarten students.
